In the identified area, the current year population is 5,219. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 4,929. The rate of change since 2010 was 0.56% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 5,315 representing a change of 0.37% annually from 2020 to 2025. Currently, the population is 50.5% male and 49.4% female.

Persons of Hispanic origin represent 11.4% of the population in the identified area compared to 18.8% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 57.6 in the identified area, compared to 65.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$48,288 in the area, compared to \$62,203 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$50,363 in five years, compared to \$67,325 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$63,152 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$65,912 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$24,568 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$25,562 in five years, compared to \$37,691 for all U.S. households

Currently, 50.7% of the 2,444 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 30.6%, renter occupied; and 18.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 2,311 housing units in the area - 52.8% owner occupied, 29.6% renter occupied, and 17.6% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.52%. Median home value in the area is \$108,840, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.21% annually to \$121,389.

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
