In the identified area, the current year population is 14,463. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 13,488. The rate of change since 2010 was 0.68% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 14,760 representing a change of 0.41% annually from 2020 to 2025. Currently, the population is 50.1% male and 49.9% female.

Persons of Hispanic origin represent 7.8% of the population in the identified area compared to 18.8% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 52.2 in the identified area, compared to 65.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 54.2% of the 7,148 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 25.3%, renter occupied; and 20.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 6,746 housing units in the area - 57.5% owner occupied, 21.8% renter occupied, and 20.7% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.61%. Median home value in the area is \$124,094, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.82% annually to \$135,788.
